#### **CLIENT SECURITY BOARD APPROVES CLAIMS**

ST. PAUL – At its June 25, 2018, meeting, the Minnesota Client Security Board approved payment of five claims, in the total amount of \$12,900, against disbarred attorneys Roy B. Henline, III and Ronald Resnik, and suspended attorneys Boris Aleksandrovich Gorshteyn and David Jason Lohse.

The Board approved one claim against disbarred attorney Roy B. Henline, III in the amount of \$3,500. The Board has now approved four claims against Henline totaling \$232,041.54. Henline last practiced law in White Bear Lake, Minnesota. He was disbarred by the Minnesota Supreme Court in March 2018.

The Board approved two claims against disbarred attorney Ronald Resnik in the amount \$7,000. The Board has now approved 16 claims against Resnik totaling \$69,336. Resnik last practiced law in Brooklyn Center, Minnesota. He was disbarred by the Minnesota Supreme Court in December 2016.

The Board approved one claim against suspended attorney Boris Aleksandrovich Gorshteyn in the amount of \$1,500. The Board has now approved three claims against Gorshteyn totaling \$21,105.79. Gorshteyn last practiced law in Excelsior, Minnesota. He was suspended by the Minnesota Supreme Court in October 2017.

The Board approved one claim against suspended attorney David Jason Lohse in the amount \$900. Lohse last practiced law in Golden Valley, Minnesota. He was suspended by the Minnesota Supreme Court in December 2017.

The Client Security Fund was established by the Minnesota Supreme Court, and is funded by Minnesota attorneys to reimburse clients who suffer loss of money or other property due to the dishonest conduct of their attorney. The Fund does not cover losses resulting from negligence of lawyers. The Fund is administered by a Board appointed by the Court, and consists of five lawyer members and two non-lawyer members. All serve without compensation as a public service.
